Year 4 Curriculum Information for Autumn Term 2009

This term Year 4 will be learning about World War II. The children will find out about the effects of the Second World War on children in their local area, nationally and internationally. They will also consider the effects of war on children today. Children will use a range of sources across the curriculum involving writing, art, ICT, Geography and participate in educational trips. Children will continue to learn German.



In Literacy children will focus on stories with historical settings where they will read short stories set in the past. They will identify and describe characters, settings and discuss similarities and differences from their own experiences.

For Numeracy children will continue to develop their number work and mental calculations. Order and find fractions of shapes and numbers. Read analogue and digital time. Handle data and carry out word problems. Children will also continue to practice their tables.

The topics for Science are Moving and Growing, and Habitats.

Homework: Children will continue to receive homework every Friday which should be returned the following Wednesday to support their reading, writing, spellings and numeracy skills.
